Basic Guideline:

• Each team must consist of 1-2 members.

Time Allocation:

3 hours total per team

- 2 hours for the design.
- 1 hour for evaluation

Rules and Regulations:

- The theme will be announced at the start of the competition.
- Posters dimensions and template will be announced during competition.
- Single Round-Participants will be given a theme at the start. They must design and submit the poster within the given time limit.
- Plagiarism or copying existing posters is strictly prohibited.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Creativity & Originality Innovative representation of the theme.
- Relevance How well the poster connects with the given theme.
- Presentation Neatness, clarity, and overall visual appeal.
- Impact Ability of the poster to convey a strong message.

Event Protocol:

- Teams should report at the venue/hall within 10 minutes after the coordinator's announcement.
- No delays are allowed. Any change in timing must be informed to the coordinator in advance.
- Failure to report on time or absence without prior notification will lead to disqualification.

Evaluation and Jury Decisions:

- The jury's decision will be final and binding.
- Any doubts or concerns regarding decisions should be directed only to the event officials.
- Non-compliance with rules or instructions from officials will result in disqualification.
